For drain 22-204 and part 22-530

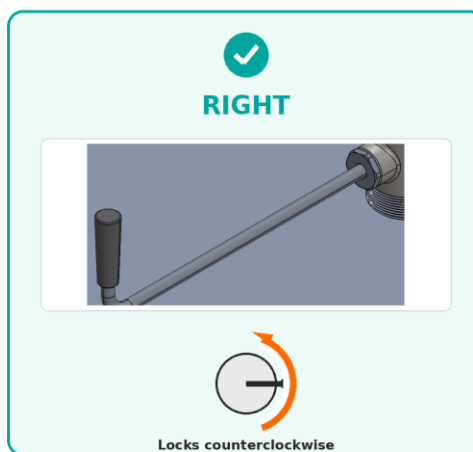
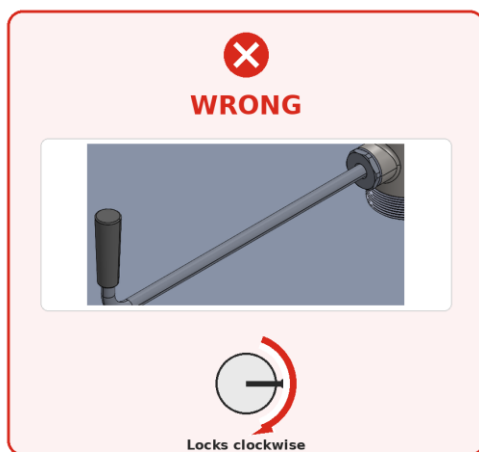
WHY THIS HAPPENS

The plunger inside the drain (22-530) is backwards. Because of this, the handle can't hold itself in an open position.

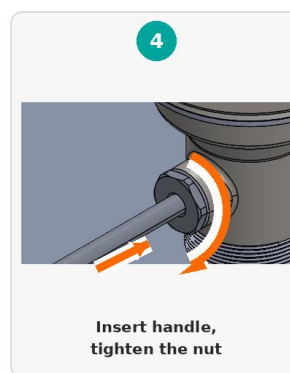
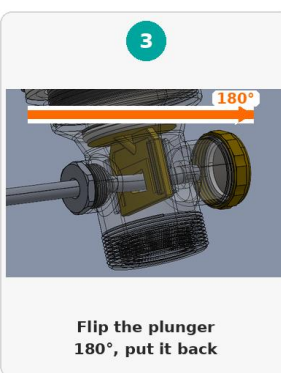
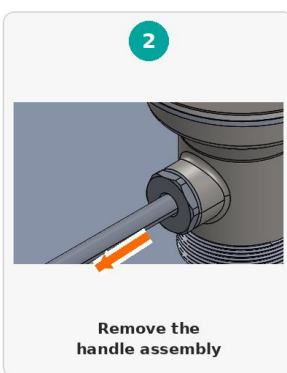
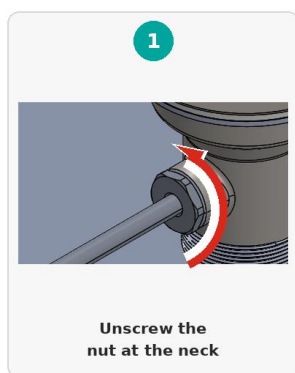
HOW TO FIX IT

Take that part out, flip it sideways, and insert it back in.

Troubleshooting



1. Unscrew the nut at the neck of the drain.
2. Remove the handle assembly (rod and nut).
3. Pop the plunger (22-530) out of its track, twist sideways 180°, and put it back.
4. Insert the handle assembly back in and tighten the nut.

TIP: When you set the part back in, point its rounded notch toward the Krowne logo located on the drain.
